

What to Look for When Reading the Bible

WORDS TO WATCH

- Look for Repeated Words or phrases
- Characters
- Patterns
- Mark Keywords
- Use Symbols and Colors



MAKE LISTS

Note details word for word Ask yourself: "What is being said about this keyword?"

For example: Keyword: "WORD" in John 1:1

- Beginning was the Word
- Word was with God
- Word was God
- Word became flesh

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LOOK FOR CONTRASTS/ COMPARISONS (Mark with /)

- Look for: but, however, nevertheless
- Similes (like or as)
- Metaphors (word pictures)

LOOK FOR TERMS OF CONCLUSION

(often used as a way to summarize what came before)

Look for: therefore, finally, for this reason

LOOK FOR TIME REFERENCES (Mark with ①)

USE SECTION HEADINGS TO WRITE YOUR OWN SUMMARY

Review section headings for a chapter(s) and summarize what is being conveyed.

ASK 5 W'S & H

- Who?
- Where?
- What?When?
- Why?How?
- ?

CHECK GRAMMATICAL STRUCTURE

- Verbs what's happening
- Subject and Object who did it to whom
- Adjectives & Adverbs descriptors
- Prepositional Phrases more details
- Pronouns who is it and are they changed

APPLY

- Know the text and yourself
- Meditate on it
- Practice it
